This course is four intensive sessions for comedians who are already gigging and want to identify and then rectify problems with their act, so is not for beginners who instead should join our Absolute & Almost Beginners comedy course.

We will focus on stage craft, writing technique, honing material and generating new ideas, so that by the end of the course you will have breathed new life into your old set, and also filled your notebook with fresh ideas to develop.

Getting better at stand-up can seem a tortuous process, but with the aid of an expert who is overflowing with tips, constructive advice, plus insights and insider info, dramatic improvements can be made in a short space of time, and you will be able to flaunt that in the showcase which concludes the course, compered by the course leader.

The course will be led by Luke Toulson who is a very experienced stand up comedian; his extensive comedy CV is [here](#). He has appeared on Russell Howard's Good News, and performs at the biggest and best comedy clubs here and abroad, including the world famous Comedy Store where he is a regular member of The Cutting Edge topical comedy team. Luke has written for comedians appearing on Mock The Week and Live at the Apollo, and has created and directed two Best Newcomer Nominated comedy shows at the Edinburgh Fringe.

The workshops are only suitable for gigging comedians because it doesn't cover the basics of stand-up.
